### Tax deduction system

## If you donate as a French taxpayer you are entitled to tax deductions:

- Income tax: individuals are entitled to an income tax deduction equivalent to 66% of the amount of their donations, with an upper limit of 20% of their taxable income. For example, a donation of €1,000 will only cost you €340 after tax deduction.
- French wealth tax: individuals liable to French wealth tax may deduct 75% of the amount of their donation, with an upper limit of €50,000. For example, a donation of €5,000 will only cost you €1,250 after tax deduction.
- Corporate tax: all sponsorship donations entitle you to a corporate tax deduction of 60% of their amount with an upper limit of 0.5% of turnover.

For example, a donation of €10,000 will only cost you €4,000 after tax deduction.

### How to make a donation

#### ► By check

#### ► By bank transfer

### If you donate as another country tax payer

Unfortunately your gift will not be entitled to tax deductions unless you are liable for French tax.
