

The duration of the Master in Finance is 2 years (Master 1 + Master 2) or 1 year (Master 2 only), depending on your latest degree.

- A 3-year Bachelor's Degree or a Licence 3 (at the minimum): You will complete the program in 2 years (M1 + M2).
- A 4-year Bachelor's Degree or a Master Degree (at the minimum): You will complete the program in 1 year (M2).

To tailor the program to each student's refined career goals, several tracks are offered during M2:

#### Corporate Finance Track

Designed for those who want to pursue a career in mergers & acquisitions, financial analysis, firm valuation, transaction services, structured financing, private equity and equity (ECM) and debt (DCM) capital markets.

#### Financial Markets Track

Designed for those who want to pursue a career in front and middle offices such as sales and structuring of financial products, traders, quantitative finance, risk management as well as asset and portfolio management.

## ■ FinTech & Analytics Track

Designed for those who want to pursue a career in quantitative asset and risk management, data-based market making and trading, quant hedge funds and jobs involving automation of traditional finance functions through technology and analytics.

# AT ESSEC FRANCE OR AT ESSEC ASIA-PACIFIC

Depending on your latest degree, you will start the program in M1 and the total duration of the program is 2 years (M1 + M2).

To build up your strength and help you build your foundations, you will begin the program with a term (T0) of preparatory courses in Finance, Mathematics and Statistics.

During the following term (T1), you will follow 6 courses from a general track (1 compulsory & 5 electives). Through this first year, you will be able to discover your professional interest, to help you decide on which track to choose in Year 2 (M2).

You will do a 6-month internship at the end of M1.

This year (M2) is divided into three terms, where you will cover: courses, 2 study trips to the major financial centers (London and New York or Hong Kong), specialized tracks, certificates in FinTech & Analytics, Energy & Commodities, and/or AMF certification (optional), and an internship or academic dissertation.

# OFFICIAL MASTER DEGREE

The Master in Finance (MIF) program is authorized by the French Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation to award a recognized BAC +5 degree, Master's Grade to its students, allowing them to apply to governmental financial aids and pursue doctoral studies afterwards.

At the end of the program, depending on which campuses students have studied at, they can apply for an Autorisation Provisioire de Séjour (APS) in France to extend their visa for 1 year and apply for jobs in Europe or a Long-Term Visit Pass (LTVP) in Singapore to stay and look for employment for 1 year.

# STUDY TRIP TO LONDON

In the beginning of M1 and M2, students accompanied with the Academic and Executive Directors travel to London. The students visit major financial institutions, such as Ardian, Arma Partners, D'Angelin & Co, Deutsche Bank, Houlihan Lokey, Lloyd's, Morgan Stanley, PIMCO, PJT Partners, RBC Capital Markets, UBS, etc. This experience allows students to discover more about the financial world in EMEA while creating new connections with professionals right at the beginning of the program. The study trip is also a perfect opportunity to develop ESSEC network and meet alumni in London.

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# STUDY TRIP TO NEW YORK OR HONG KONG

During M2 students choose to travel either one of the major financial centers either New York or Hong Kong, where they meet and exchange views with professionals in the most prestigious investment banks and consulting firms such as Ardian, Barclay's Capital, Bank of America-Merrill Lynch, BNP-Paribas, Blackstone, CA CIB, CiTi, Goldman Sachs, Hoolihan Lokey, HSBC, Jefferies, J.P. Morgan, KKR, Morgan Stanley, Natixis, Société Générale, Standard & Poor's and UBS.

# **RESEARCH SEMINARS**

ESSEC Business School's Finance Department along with the Research Center holds research seminars throughout the academic year where guest speakers present the most recent theoretical and empirical research in finance.

In addition to the faculty, the program also relies on lecturers and practitioners who are experts in their field.


# CFA PROGRAM PARTNER

The CFA Institute oversees the international professional qualification of Chartered Financial Analyst.

Students who wish to pursue career in areas such as mergers and acquisitions, project financing, structuring, equity analysis, fixed income analysis, portfolio management or equity sales, have the opportunity to prepare for the CFA Institute exam during their studies.

Through its partnership with the CFA, Master in Finance students interested in taking the CFA exams (Level I, II or III) in June are eligible for a number of scholarships covering the exam fees.



Selection is based on an exceptional academic record and/ or professional experience as well as strong motivation to pursue the ESSEC Master in Finance.


There are several rounds of application each year.
